

Social Prescribing Support for Service Users with Language Needs

SIS can provide a triage service and Light Social Prescribing across Sussex

- SIS have a team of Volunteer Bilingual Social Prescribers in the 21 most commonly spoken languages
- o The team provides a social prescribing triage service to ascertain the needs of Service Users
- They deliver light social prescribing support and/or make onward referrals to social prescribing caseworkers

SIS Light Social Prescribing helps overcome language, culture, power and information barriers

- explaining public service systems and structures
- o understanding correspondence
- o finding relevant translated information
- o completing simple forms
- linking with specialist services
- making appointments
- asserting the right to language support and requesting interpreters

Interpreting provision for link workers and social prescribers

Some Service Users have multiple complex needs which require more motivational support and guidance. SIS Volunteers will make onward referrals for casework.

In Brighton and Hove, SIS is commissioned to provide professional Bilingual Community Navigators to deliver specialist casework https://sussexinterpreting.org.uk/social-prescribing/

In East and West Sussex, Volunteers will refer to PCN linkworkers.
