



Q1 When did you join the Health Promotion Project?




Q2 How did you find out about SIS?



Q3 Are you still, or planning to continue, volunteering for SIS?




Q4 How do you rate the support and services SIS provides you?





Q5 On as scale of 0 to 10 stars, how likely is it that you would recommend SIS to a friend or colleague?










Q10 To what extent has volunteering for SIS HPP met your expectations in these areas?




